

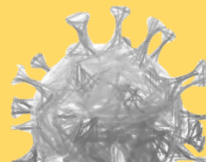
RECAP OF IMPACT AND OUTREACH BY THE EHHD COVID-19 MARCH 2020 THROUGH MAY 11, 2023

Across Connecticut, the COVID-19 pandemic was a significant event. In the 10 EHHD member towns with a population of just under 80,000 approximately 18% had lab-reported positive tests for COVID-19 during this period.

- Lab-reported cases include PCR and antigen tests reported to the CT DPH CTEDSS system.
- Calls include all attempts to cases and contacts recorded through the ContaCT portal. Many did not result in interviews, while others are multiple calls to the same case or contact for follow-up or monitoring. 93% of calls made to residents were placed by EHHD (CT DPH contracted callers placed 7% calls).
- Vaccination (Vax) events are those provided by EHHD and do not include events provided in the EHHD member towns through Griffin Health or Hartford Healthcare.
- Vaccination total reflects vaccine provided by the EHHD during home visits, and EHHD clinics at schools, community events and venues, senior centers, truck stops, farmer's markets, flea markets & town events.
- EHHD sent out 195 reports to stakeholders during this period, starting as daily briefings and shifting to weekly updates.
