

Environmental Health Intern

The Eastern Highland Health District (EHHD) is seeking a summer student intern.

The student intern receives direct supervision from the Office Manager. Example of duties include: conducts water sampling of public bathing areas; assists in performing environmental health office duties; assists in establishing environmental health data bases, report forms, templates and other computer related activities; assists with environmental health record keeping; conducts special environmental health related office projects as needed; provides statistical and narrative reports of activities as needed; assists in monitoring existing questionable properties; conducts water sampling of potable water sources.

No experience needed. **Hourly wage available.** This is a part-time seasonal position with flexible hours. Enrollment in an undergraduate level program related to biology, medicine, engineering, environmental sciences or public health related field of study recommended.
